

CHAPTER 10

10.1 SOURCES OF REVENUE

10.1.1 Marshall County

The Board of Education, as provided by Section nine, article eight of chapter eleven, shall impose a levy for the maintenance and operation of all schools in the county. This levy shall be uniform throughout the county and the funds shall be distributed and expended without regard to the locality from which collected.

Discussion of details and exceptions may be found in West Virginia Code, Chapter 18, Article 9, Section 1.

10.1.2 State of West Virginia (State Aid) (Revised 05/09/95)

The basic foundation program for each county for the fiscal year shall be the sum of the amounts computed in accordance with the provisions found in West Virginia Code, Chapter 18, Article 9A, Section 4-10, inclusive. On the first working day of July in each year, the state board shall determine the basic foundation program for each county for that fiscal year. The allocated state aid share of the county's basic foundation program shall be the difference between the cost of it's basic foundation program and the county's local share as determined in 18-9A-11.

Section 10- Foundation allowance to improve instructional programs.

10.1.3 United States of America (Federal Aid)

The Board of Education of Marshall County shall apply for and participate in any (and all) programs of federal aid available to its schools, at such times and for such reasons as it may deem desirable, in the manner and method as set forth by the government of the United States of America.

The above shall be done in compliance with the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education and the State Department of Education.

10.1.4 Miscellaneous Sources

10.1.4.1 Gift, Grant, or Bequest

The board, according to law and the intent of the instrument conferring title, shall receive, hold and dispose of any gift, grant, or bequest. (West Virginia Code, Chapter 18, Article 5, Section 5)

10.1.4.2 Tuition

Any tuition fees paid to the board of education shall be received and used for general expenses unless otherwise designated for a specific purpose.

10.1.4.3 Rental of Buildings and Equipment

Any rental fees paid to the board of education shall be received and used for general expenses unless otherwise designated for a specific purpose.
