The Marshall County Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, April 25, 2017, 6:00 p.m., at the Board of Education Offices, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Vice President John Miller, Members Lori E. Kestner, Dr. Duane Miller, Christie Robison; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

Howard O’Cull, WVSBA Executive Director, reviewed with the Board processes that may be used in the Superintendent selection. Dr. O’Cull said a Superintendent must be appointed by June 1, 2017. He explained how other Boards have approached the process. It can be as simple as taking applications and interviewing or can involve community and employees in the search process.
