The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Tuesday, August 18, 2015, 5:30 p.m., at the Administrative Office Conference Room at John Marshall High School, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Beth A. Phillips, Vice President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Members Lori E. Kestner, John Miller, Dr. Duane Miller; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The purpose of the workshop is to discuss goals for the Board of Education and the Superintendent.

The Board reviewed the state guidelines to prepare for goal setting and discussed with the Superintendent goals for both the Superintendent and the Board, each having at least two goals, one being mutual. The mutual goal would be to increase the communication between Marshall County Schools and the public of Marshall County. In addition, the Board's goals will be to improve financial stewardship, increase interaction with staff between schools, monitor growth of student learning achievement, develop an active relationship with local legislatures, and be active in school/community events.

The Superintendent's goals will focus on increasing growth of students' standardized test scores and increase his leadership and visibility within the state and local community.

Following the goal setting, the Board toured John Marshall High School.
