The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Monday, October 10, 2016, 6:30 p.m., at the Board of Education Office, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Beth A. Phillips, Vice President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Members Lori E. Kestner, John Miller, Dr. Duane Miller; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The purpose of the workshop is to discuss goals for the Board of Education and the Superintendent.

President Phillips reviewed the state guidelines to prepare for goal setting and discussed with the Superintendent goals for both he and the Board, each having at least two goals, and two mutual goals. The mutual goals are (1) to improve academic achievement and (2) to maintain a focus on student needs and fiscal responsibility. In addition, the Board set a goal to increase interaction of the staff between schools and also maintain and reinforce active relationships with local officials. The third goal for the Superintendent is to develop site-based leadership within schools.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Kestner, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

President Phillips adjourned the workshop at 8:40 p.m.
