The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Tuesday, October 18, 2016, 6:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Beth A. Phillips, Vice President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Members Lori E. Kestner, John Miller, Dr. Duane Miller; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

A student expulsion hearing for student SDA 16/17-03 was conducted.

Assistant Superintendent Corey Murphy presented the case. Present were mother, step-father and student.

The parents requested an open hearing.

President Phillips acted as Hearing Officer.

Superintendent Hince's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 16/17-03 be expelled from John Marshall School for a period not to exceed one school year.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, and seconded by Vice President Gilbert, that the Board will expel SDA 16/17-03 from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year. Motion carried.

This falls under the habitually violating school rules and policies West Virginia Code 18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Kestner, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

President Phillips adjourned the meeting at 7:15 p.m.
