Internet Search Using Key Words

Go to <http://www.google.com>

Type in at least two **key words** that relate to your topic

- Choose your key words **wisely**
- Make key words as **specific** as possible
- You **do not** need to include common words like “and,” “where,” and “how.” If a common word is a necessary part of your search, put a “+” before the common word
- Google searches are **not** case sensitive
- To search for information on a **specific phrase**, (such as part of a speech) enclose the phrase in quotation marks.

Scroll through your results – by skimming the description of the site content, you should be able to find a site that will give you the information that you need.
