The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Saturday, February 7, 2015, 9:00 a.m., at the Transportation Department and John Marshall High School Room 240, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Beth A. Phillips, Vice President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Members Lori E. Kestner, John Miller, Dr. Duane Miller; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The Board discussed current bus issues and reviewed transportation needs with Dave Smith and toured the facility. Dave Smith discussed the need to replace two hoists for busses that may not pass inspection in the near future. His wish list included the increase of mechanic's pay, resurfacing the parking lot, a new in ground oil separator for the wash bay, roof leak repairs and some new windows.

The Board then met at John Marshall High School. Casey Storm reviewed the building & field use contracts and discussed possible changes. He stressed that contracts need to be consistent throughout the county.

Ron Blatt from PCS gave the Board an update on the John Marshall construction, and the Board toured the building of the current work which includes a new kitchen area, the front entry-way and science rooms.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Kestner, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
