The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Monday, February 6, 2012, 6:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President David L. Hall, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The parents of SDA 11/12-10 requested to postpone the expulsion hearing to seek legal counsel and waived all timelines. Motion by Mrs. Kestner and seconded by Vice President Hall that the Board approve the request. Motion carried.

President Lewicki announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion of SDA 11/12-12.

President Lewicki acted as Hearing Officer.

Assistant Superintendent Wayne Simms proffered the student's case.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mrs. Kestner that the Board go in to closed session. Motion carried.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mr. Gilbert that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Superintendent Renzella's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 11/12-12 be expelled from Cameron High School for the remainder of the school year.

Motion by Vice President Hall, seconded by Mrs. Kestner, and motion carried that the Board will uphold the Superintendent's recommendation to expel SDA 11/12-12 from Cameron High School for the remainder of the school year.

This falls under the habitually violating school rules and policies West Virginia Code 18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.
