The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Tuesday, March 4, 2014, 7:00 p.m., at the John Marshall High School Center for Performing Arts, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President Lori E. Kestner, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., John Miller, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

This special meeting is to conduct a Public Hearing for the 2014-15 School Calendar.

Superintendent Michael Hince presented an explanation of the process, mandatory changes, the results of the Online Calendar Survey and an open forum for public comment. Mr. Hince highlighted some of the important legislative changes regarding the calendar that includes 48 weeks to complete the school year, all instructional time missed due to cancellations or delays must be made up, must have 180 separate instruction days, No ISE days, must provide faculty senates 2 hours time to meet, calendar should extend out to June 30th (Out of Calendar Days) to allow make-up days, Six (6) OS days must be provided, Six (6) other Non-Instructional Days must be scheduled (including CE time), Seven (7) Legal Holidays, and Election Day.

There were 1059 respondents to the Online Survey and 387 comments were made.

There were approximately 25 questions asked by the public and Mr. Hince responded to each one.

Motion by Mr. Miller and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

President Lewicki adjourned the meeting at 8:40 p.m.
