President Lewicki announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion of SDA 12/13-10.

Motion by Mrs. Phillips and seconded by Mr. Miller that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion of SDA 12/13-10. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Miller and seconded by Mr. Gilbert that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Superintendent Renzella's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 12/13-10 be expelled from Cameron High School for a period not to exceed one school year.

Motion by Vice President Kestner, seconded by Mrs. Phillips, and motion carried that the Board will expel SDA 12/13-10 from Cameron High School for the remainder of the school year.
