The Marshall County Board of Education met in regular session Thursday, October 27, 2011, 7:30 p.m., at Cameron Elementary School, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President David L. Hall, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The Board met and conferred with representatives from the Local School Improvement Councils of Cameron High School and Cameron Elementary.

Principals Wendy Clutter and Wyatt O'Neil spoke on behalf of Cameron Elementary and Cameron High School Improvement Councils. The Principals discussed their goals. A mock PLC meeting was demonstrated by elementary teachers. Mrs. Frazier and Ms. Cecil reviewed data breakdown of Westest results through observations and inferences. Two high school students spoke before the Board and commented on the advantages of the modified schedule at Cameron High School.
