The Marshall County Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, November 13, 2012, 7:00 p.m., at the Board of Education Offices, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President Lori E. Kestner, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., John Miller, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

Principal Corey Murphy, Josh Gary and Sally Gaughenbaugh presented the John Marshall High School Improvement Council PowerPoint. The presentation highlighted the school's achievements and academics.

Woody Yoder, Principal, spoke on behalf of the Center McMechen Elementary School Improvement Council. Mr. Yoder highlighted CMES accomplishments. He stated this was made possible only through the collective and consistent work of the staff. In addition, Mr. Yoder introduced to the Board the new state evaluation system procedures for professional staff.

Gary Rider discussed and reviewed the release of Volume III - *Marshall County Patriots and Heroes*.

David Hall spoke to the Board about the new Cameron High School and expressed what a spectacular facility that will provide wonderful opportunities for all of our students and enable our students to adequately move on to the next educational level.

Ron McCoy expressed that the Cameron Baptist Church has interest in acquiring the old Cameron High School in the event the city did not obtain the facility.

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Mr. Simms explained to the Board that Marshall County Schools' insurance carrier indicated that improvements need to be made on the Paint Spray Booth at the bus garage. Investigations will occur to determine if it is more cost efficient to repair or construct a new booth on the outside.

Mr. Renzella distributed an email update to the Board regarding the John Marshall Baseball Field. President Lewicki requested that the Board receive a monthly update on this matter.
