Mrs. Erin Cuffaro, Director of Special Programs, presented an update to the Board regarding Special Education. The West Virginia Department of Education has identified Central Elementary as a Comprehensive Support and Improvement -Additional Targeted Support (CSI-ATS) School that does not meet standards in the special education subcategory. This is a special designation for Title I schools and provides the support of two state department personnel in the department of special education and one personnel in school improvement. Additional Title I funds will be allocated to support a plan of school improvement to target special education scores. We have implemented an Insights to Behavior Program. Last spring, each school comprised a team including principals, regular education teachers, special education teachers and/or counselors. This program allows Marshall County Schools to provide intervention to our Tier 2 behavior students. The goal is to ensure these students have strategies to make them successful during the school day.
