In the summer of 2024, the administration of Marshall County Schools released a professional development catalog containing the details of all summer trainings including who is eligible, deadlines and how to register. We had overwhelmingly positive feedback from this; therefore, we are doing the same for the fall.

Each page in this document describes a professional development opportunity, timelines, compensation, criteria to be eligible to register, and directions on how to register. Not every training is for every employee. The qualifications for eligibility of each training are listed.

It is not mandatory for any training to be completed for stipend pay; these are simply opportunities for personal growth that will positively impact student performance. If a training is mandatory per state code, anyone who does not complete the training for pay will simply have to complete that training during a designated professional development day built into the school calendar.

If you are earning a stipend for training, the work must be completed outside of your contracted work hours.

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HB 3035 Initial Dyscalculia Training

Dyscalculia is slowly getting more attention in the world of education. One can assume that as the science of reading gains more and more traction, people have started to wonder about math as well. While dyslexia is being studied extensively, the same cannot be said for dyscalculia even though there are some estimates that the prevalence rates are nearly identical for both disorders. This course is an introduction into dyscalculia which is also known as a specific learning disability in math. The information in this course will inform participants on what dyscalculia is and is not, the need for screenings and early interventions, connections between foundational numeracy skills and dyslexia, and when special education services may be appropriate. Knowledge gained through this course is to help guide educational practices within the school system and is **not** to be utilized for diagnostic purposes. Our hope is that this course will empower your teaching practices for students struggling in math.




