9. Safety & Parking Concerns (Chief Vogler)

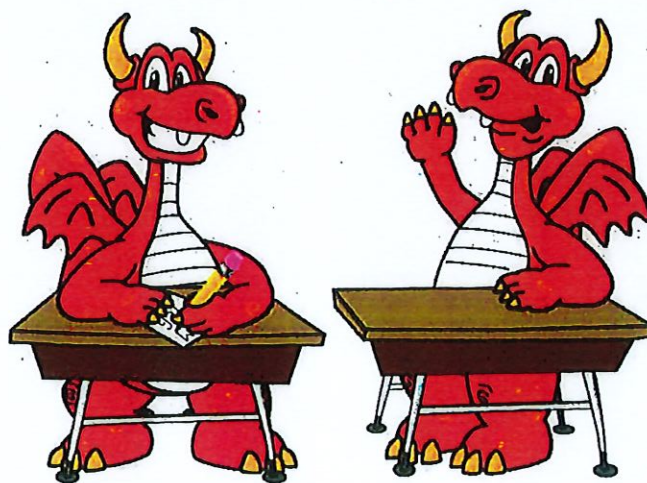
- **No Parking Signs:** Installed on the grassy area of 7th Street to improve student safety.

Glen Dale Elementary Strategic Plan Goals

2025-2026

1. Glen Dale Elementary will increase the percentage of all students in each grade level (grades 3-5) who are performing at the proficiency level in the Reading/Language Arts and Math subject areas by 5% as evidenced from the previous school year to current school year summative assessment results.
2. Based on Acadience Benchmark beginning of the year & ending of year assessments, the reading composite score for grade K-2 will increase to 70% at or above benchmark as evidenced by the end of the year benchmark.



Be an AtTENDance Hero Plan

Goal

To encourage strong attendance and celebrate students who miss **fewer than 10 days for the entire school year.**

How We Will Share the Goal

- Display “Be an AtTENDance Hero” posters in hallways and classrooms.
- Share information in school newsletters.
- Remind students and families throughout the year.

Student Progress Tracking

- Each student will track their own attendance using the **AtTENDance Hero Chart**.
- At the end of each nine weeks, students will take home their chart with their updated attendance percentage.
- Parents will receive these charts to stay informed and involved.

Recognition & Incentives

1. **AtTENDance Hero Board**
 - At the end of each nine weeks, a photo wall will feature the **AtTENDance Heroes**—students with **perfect attendance or only one absence or less** during that grading period.
2. **Certificates**
 - Students with perfect or near-perfect attendance (0–1 days absent) will receive an **AtTENDance Hero Certificate** each nine weeks.
3. **Special Rewards**
 - Students who qualify will also receive a small reward such as an **AtTENDance Hero bracelet, sticker, or trinket** to celebrate their accomplishment.

Family Connection

- Parents will receive the updated **attendance chart** every nine weeks.
- This helps families monitor progress and support their child’s attendance goal.

End-of-Year Goal

- Students who miss **fewer than 10 days all year** will be celebrated as **AtTENDance Heroes** with recognition and rewards.

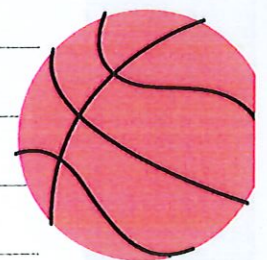
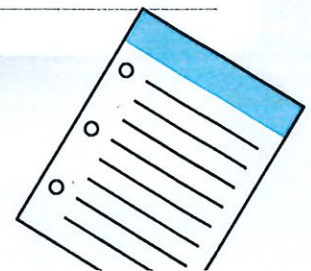
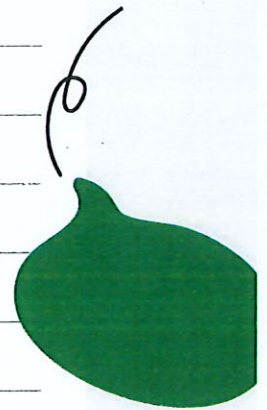
PBIS

Dragon Dollars

We are excited to share how our PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) system at Glen Dale Elementary encourages positive behavior and citizenship through our unique Dragon Dollars program! Each classroom operates its own management system, but school-wide, we utilize Dragon Dollars to reinforce good behavior. Students have the chance to earn \$10 Dragon Dollars per week, with adjustments made for school breaks or shorter weeks.

Every day, students can earn \$1 from their classroom teacher, and they can also earn five additional dollars throughout the week in music, art, guidance, lunch, and gym. However, students may lose a dollar per day if they do not adhere to the rules and expectations outlined in the student handbook. These guidelines are prominently displayed in various school areas to serve as reminders.

Our PBIS rewards for the nine-week period are showcased on a bulletin board at the school's front entrance. Students can spend their Dragon Dollars at the school store twice a month or save them for experience tickets available each nine weeks, often themed around the current season. We collaborate with programs at John Marshall to make these experiences enjoyable and engaging. Thank you for supporting our efforts to cultivate a positive school environment.
