
### 9. Safety & Parking Concerns (Chief Vogler)

### Glen Dale Elementary Strategic Plan Goals 2025-2026

- 1. Glen Dale Elementary will increase the percentage of all students in each grade level (grades 3-5) who are performing at the proficiency level in the Reading/Language Arts and Math subject areas by 5% as evidenced from the previous school year to current school year summative assessment results.
- 2. Based on Acadience Benchmark beginning of the year & ending of year assessments, the reading composite score for grade K-2 will increase to 70% at or above benchmark as evidenced by the end of the year benchmark.

### 3. Special Rewards




