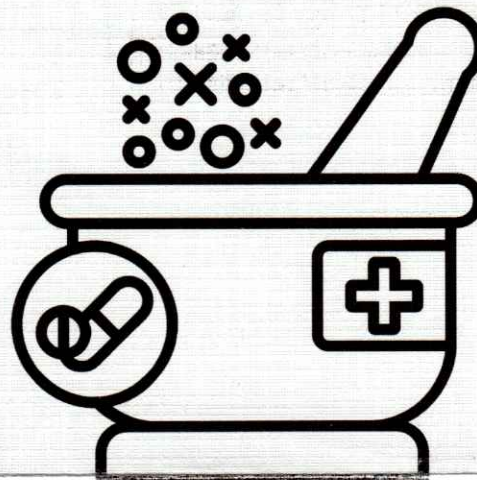

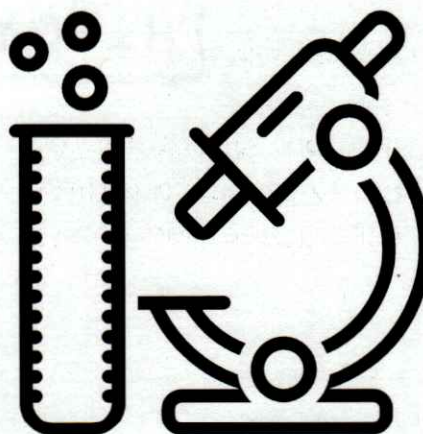
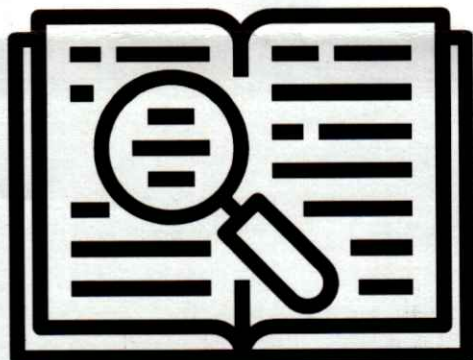
The program is intended to recognize outstanding high school seniors with provisional early assurance to the MUSOP PharmD program. Students who are admitted into this program are expected to meet all requirements to successfully matriculate into the MUSOP PharmD Program at the beginning of their third year at the university.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Must enroll as a freshman directly from high school
- Must choose Biology or Chemistry as major and pre-pharmacy as intended concentration.
- All prerequisites must be taken at Marshall or approved partner institution.
- Must maintain continuous full-time university enrollment (excluding summer terms).
- Must earn a 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA each undergraduate semester.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 3.4 unweighted high school GPA
- 24 composite ACT (with Math subscore of 21) OR a SAT composite score of 1160

HOW TO APPLY

- Submit all items for undergrad admission to Marshall University.
- Submit the MUSOP Early Assurance Application and nonrefundable \$50 application fee no later than **June 1** of your high school graduation year.
